

# Educators take Flight with Flying WILD at Landmark Park in July 2019!



**Flying WILD Morning Workshop: \$25** - This workshop will focus on the Flying WILD program, providing participants with a lot of great environmental education activities that teach about bird conservation. Educators that participate in this workshop will learn about the importance of migratory birds, the conservation efforts that are needed to protect them as well as how to better understand and appreciate birds in and around your community and campus.
